GENUINE

Definition:

A person who is genuine is one who is real and who shows on the outside how he feels on the inside.

Examples and/or Questions to Ask the Children:

1. Genuine leather belt vs. fake leather belt.
2. Fool's gold vs. real gold.
3. "GENUINE" picture from *Children's Character Book* published by Living Stream Ministry.

Verse:

"... *the genuineness also of your love.*" 2 Corinthians 8:8b

Craft Ideas:

1. Have the children make **genuine** fingerprints of their fingers using an ink pad.
2. They can add whiskers, eyes, legs, etc. when the ink dries to create little fingerprint animals, objects, etc.

[Materials needed - Stamp pad, paper, fine line markers or pens]
