Character Lesson Ten

STABLE

Definition:

A stable person doesn't change easily but is calm, dependable, unwavering, and not easily upset by his environment.

Examples and/or Questions to Ask the Children:

1. The Lord Jesus passed through many tests and judgments, but He stayed very calm.
2. When a fire alarm or tornado siren sounds, you listen to your parent's or the teacher's instructions and stay calm.

Verse:

"... but let your yes be yes, and your no be no..." James 5:12m

Craft Ideas:

Have the children make plaster of Paris, impressions of their hand. See attached paper for further instructions.

WALL PLAQUE

MATERIALS:

Plastic lid

Plaster of Paris

Toothpicks or pencil

Large paper clips

A coffee lid or a butter tub lid will work as a base for plaster. Pour the plaster into the lid and press a handprint. Use a tooth pick to write a name and date. Before the plaster hardens insert a large paper clip so it can be hung up later. When the plaque is dry it will no longer feel cold to the touch. Pop the plaster away from the lid. These can be painted.
