LESSON ELEVEN

The Effect of the Gospel— Making Sinners Sons of God to live the Church Life

I. Newly saved people are like newborn babes, who need much care and shepherding; within 72 hours, we need to visit, care, shepherd, or invite them for a love feast, followed by continual shepherding, including:

- A. Encouraging and accompanying them to pray for their families, friends, etc.
- B. Encouraging them to build up the habit of reading the Bible and having morning revival regularly.
- C. Encouraging and accompanying them to visit their friends and preach the gospel to them.
- D. Encouraging and helping them to open their homes for home meetings, love feasts for friends, preaching the gospel in the homes, etc.
- E. Encouraging them to testify for the Lord and strengthening their faith.
- F. Helping them establish the habit of pursuing the truth and meeting regularly.
- G. Holding systematic new believers' perfecting trainings for them.
- H. Bringing them into the foretaste of a corporate God-man living.

II. Newly saved people are fresh gospel preachers and members of the Body who desire to function; we need to bring them into the building up of the Body practically by:

- A. Encouraging them to actively invite people to their homes for meals and gospel preaching.
- B. Encouraging them to coordinate and participate in some services that take care of people, such as serving the children, young people, young working saints, etc.
- C. Encouraging them to coordinate and participate in some services that take care of affairs, such as serving in the bookroom, kitchen, cleaning, maintenance, transportation, etc.
- D. Encouraging them to be blended in the Body by visiting other churches, attending conferences and trainings, etc.
- E. Helping them have the proper understanding of financial offerings and practice it.

III. After people are saved for a while, they need to learn to take care of other newly saved ones and become shepherds to function normally in the church life, including:

- A. Building up a normal life style and pursuing a regular living.
- B. Learning to serve the new ones by following the points under Roman numeral one, for example.

- C. Serving in the new believers' perfecting training.
- D. Opening their homes to practice the corporate God-man living or moving into a home where such living is practiced.
- E. Preaching the gospel fervently and leading others to do the same.
