THE LORD'S TABLE MEETING

Is for the remembrance of the Lord and the worship of the Father

Memory verses: "And having given thanks, He broke it and said, This is My body, which is given for you; this do unto the remembrance of Me. Similarly also the cup after they had dined, saying, This cup is the new covenant established in My blood; this do, as often as you drink it, unto the remembrance of Me." I Corinthians 11:24-25

- 1. The believers come together to eat the Lord's supper and attend the Lord's table.
- 2. The Lord is the center of enjoyment.
- 3. The two major aspects of the Lord's table meeting are:
 - A. Vertical aspect remembrance of the Lord's person, not His work.
 - B. Horizontal aspect fellowship with all the members of the Body of Christ.
- 4. How do we remember the Lord?
 - A. The breaking of the bread is that we may eat it.
 - B. The partaking of the cup is that we may drink it.
- 5. How do we fellowship?

We fellowship with all the members of the Body of Christ by partaking of the same bread and by drinking of the same cup.

- 6. We come to the Lord's table meeting to receive the Lord into us.
- Lord's table also displays the Lord's death. By the death of the Lord, all negative things have come to an end. The old creation is ended. His new creation has begun.
- Lord's table expresses our hope.
 We are to declare the Lord's death until He comes.
 In His first coming we have His death to carry out redemption.
 In His second coming He will have the Kingdom. He will establish this Kingdom to be God's universal administration.
